

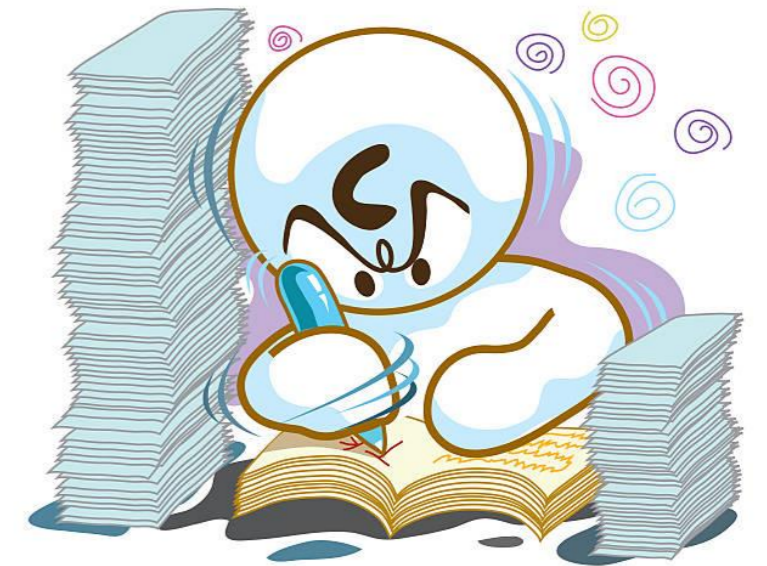
ENGLISH TIPS

Correct Eventually, I had to get a taxi to take me to the hospital.
